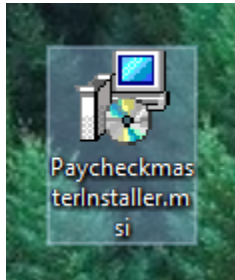


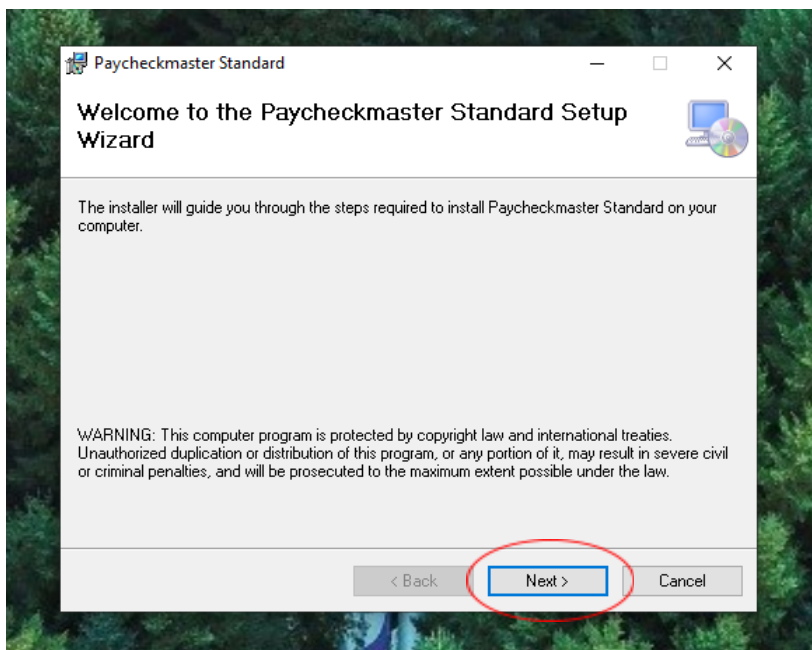

Installing Paycheckmaster Standard

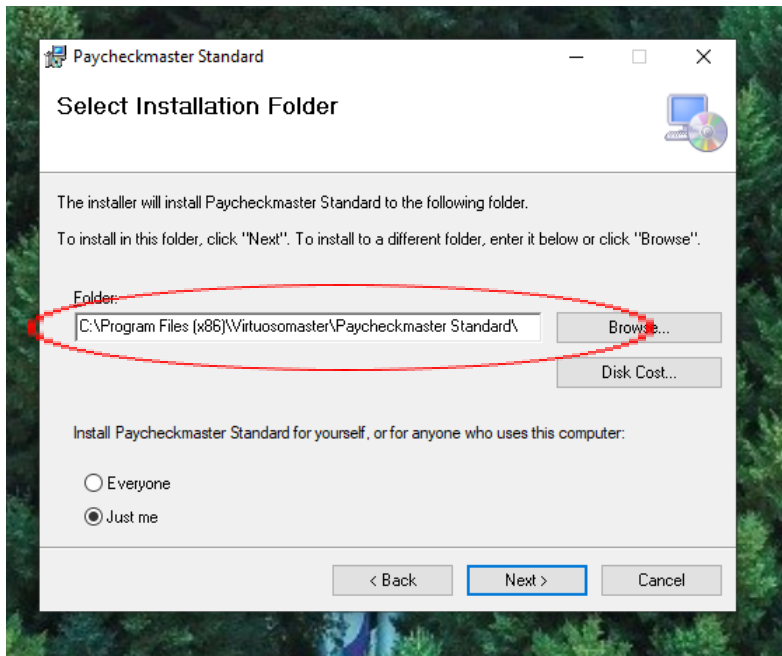
1. Double-click "PaycheckmasterInstaller.exe" to run the setup for Paycheckmaster Standard.



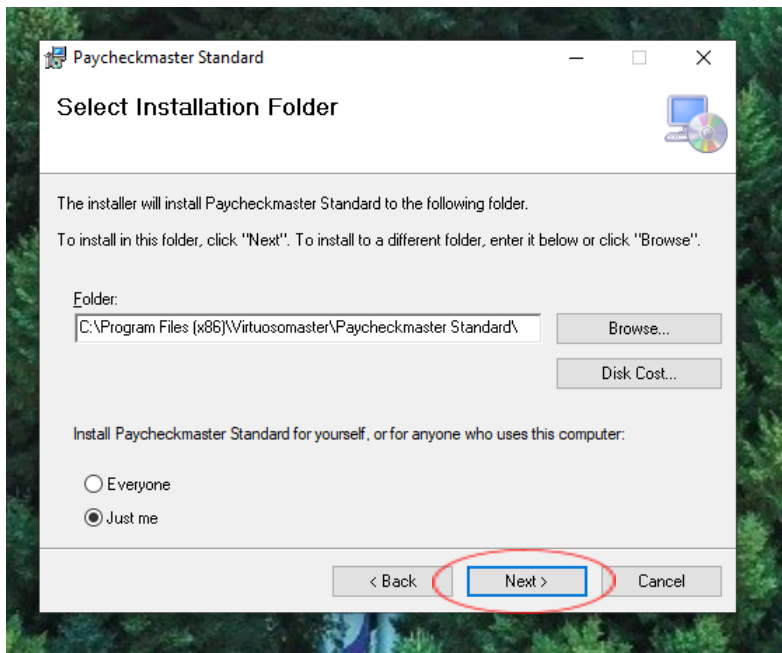
2. On the window that appears, click "Next".



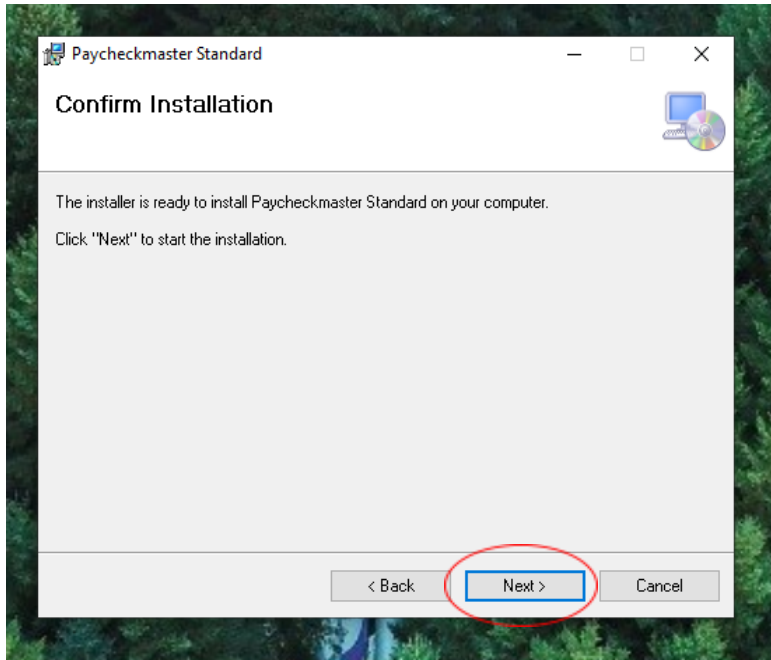
3. On the next screen, set Folder to "C:\Program Files (x86)\Virtuosomaster\Paycheckmaster Standard". NOTE: No need to change anything if this is already the setting.



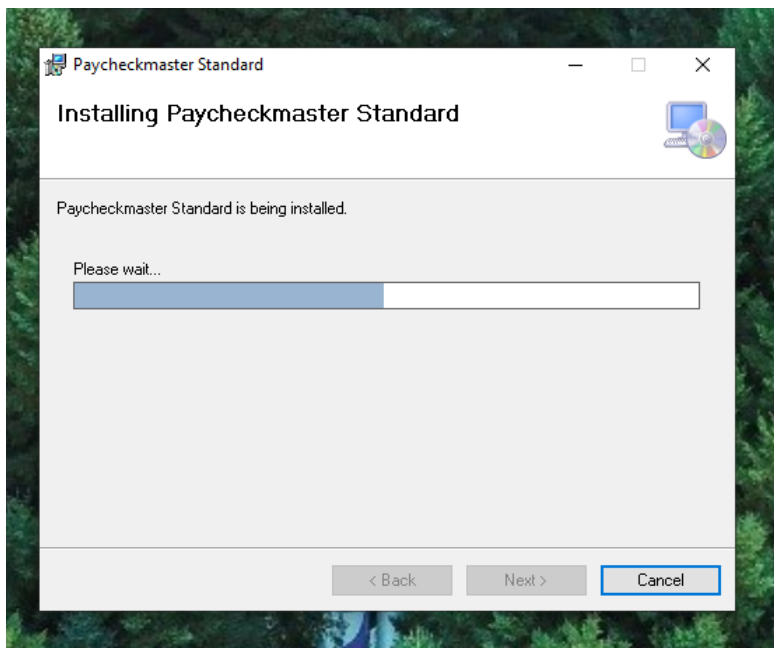
4. Click "Next".



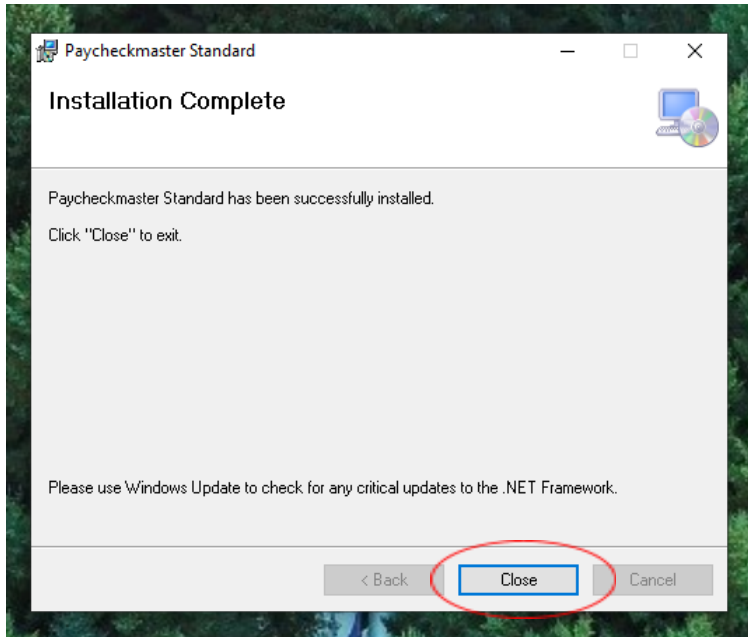
5. Continue clicking "Next" until it starts the installation process.



6. Wait for the installation to finish.




7. Click "Close" to close the installation window. NOTE: Do not run Paycheckmaster Standard until you have completed all of the database installation and setup steps that follow.

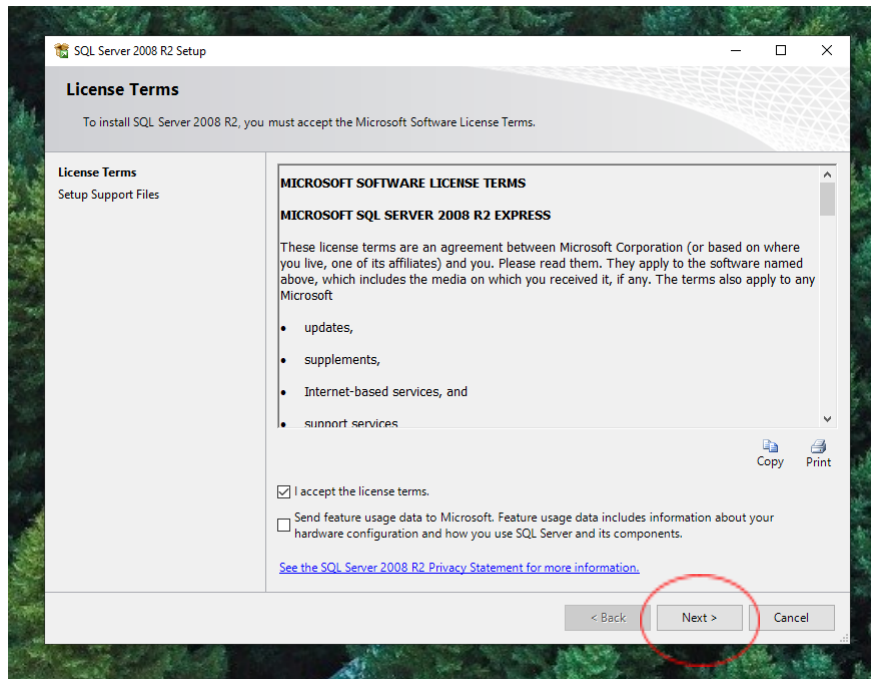
5. On the SQL Server Installation Center window, click "New installation or add features to an existing installation".



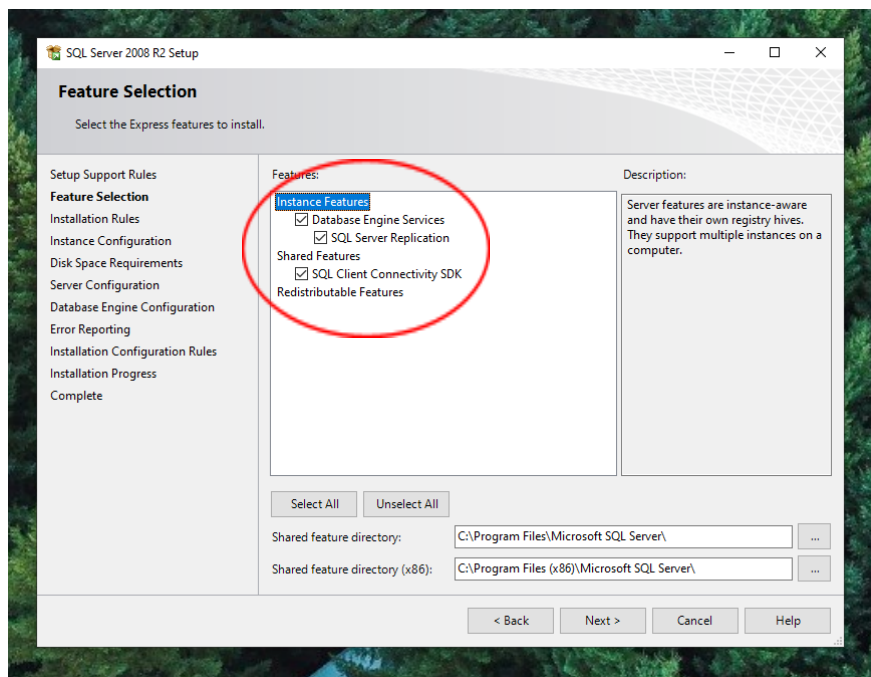
6. On the SQL Server 2008 R2 Setup window, on License Terms, check "I accept the license terms".



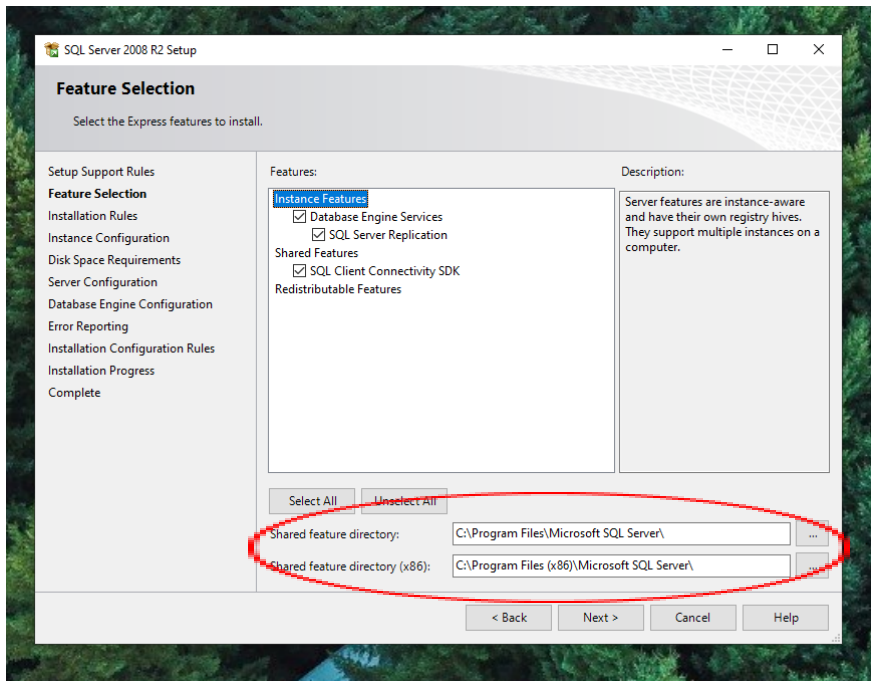
7. Click "Next" and wait for the process to finish.



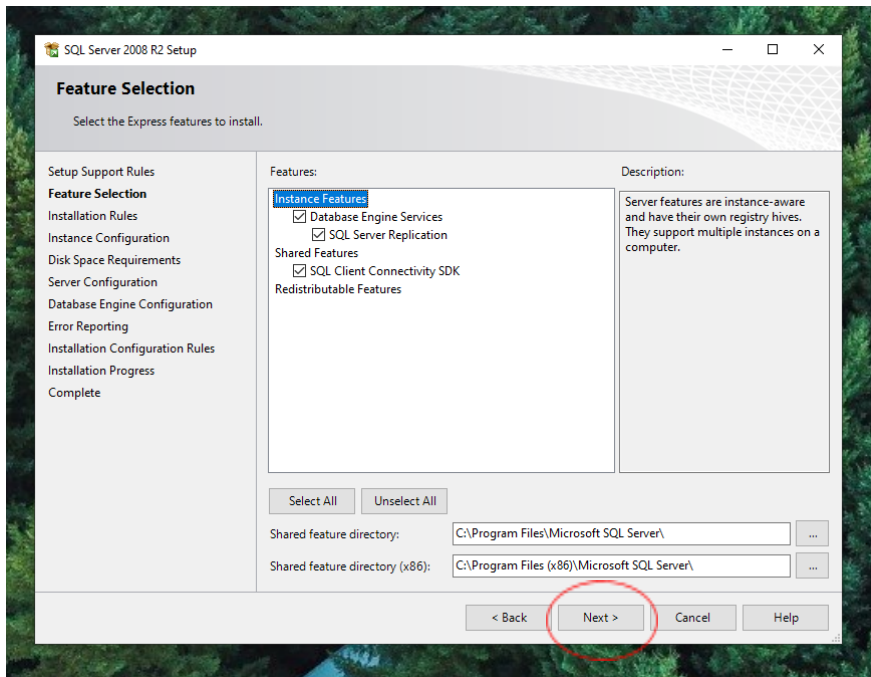
8. On Feature Selection, under Features, check "Database Engine Services", "SQL Server Replication", and "SQL Client Connectivity SDK".



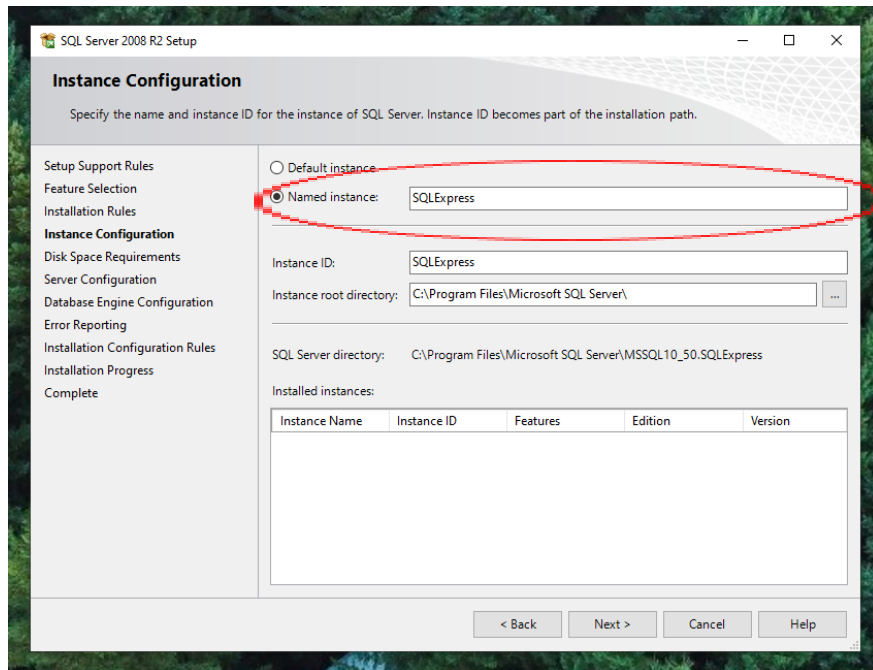

- NOTE: No need to change anything if these are already the settings.



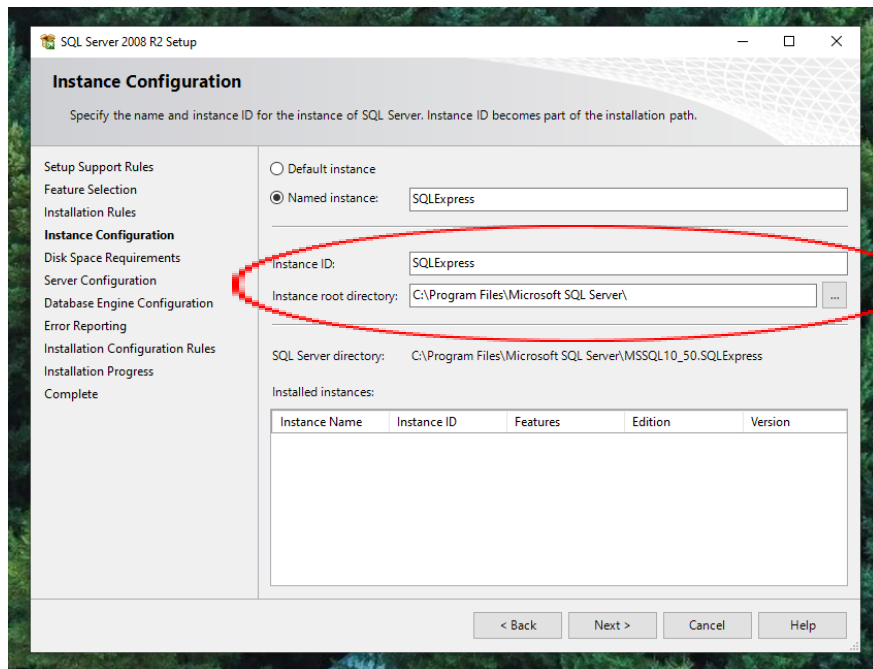
10. Click "Next".



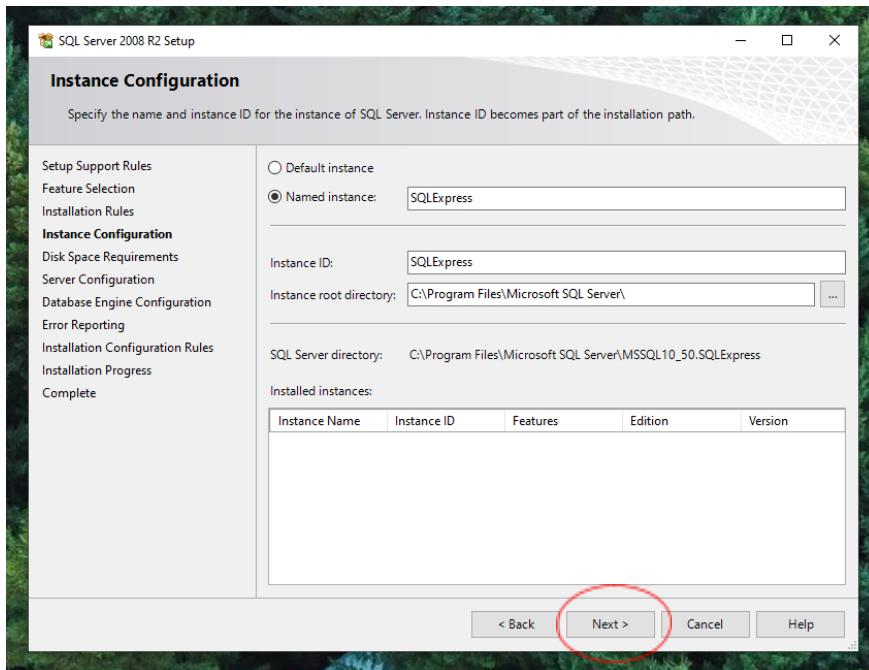
11. On Instance Configuration, choose "Named instance" and input "SQLEXPRESS" in the following textbox. NOTE: No need to change anything if these are already the settings.



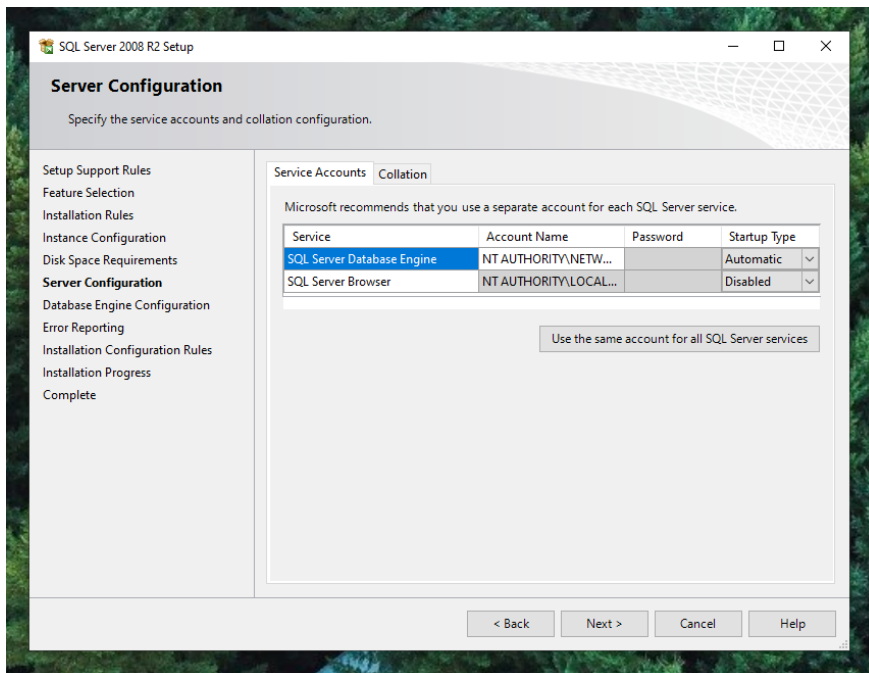

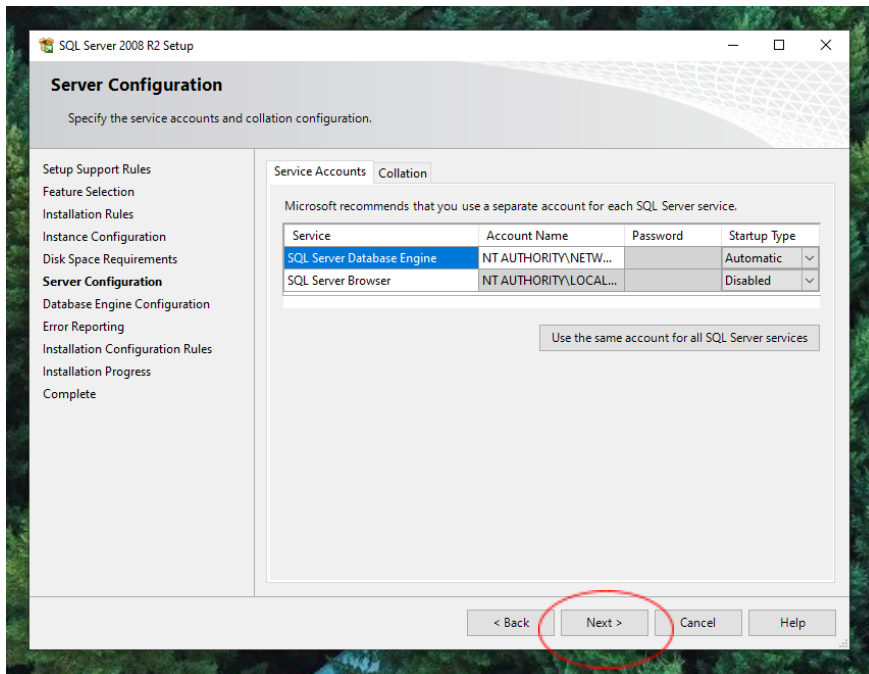
13. Click "Next".



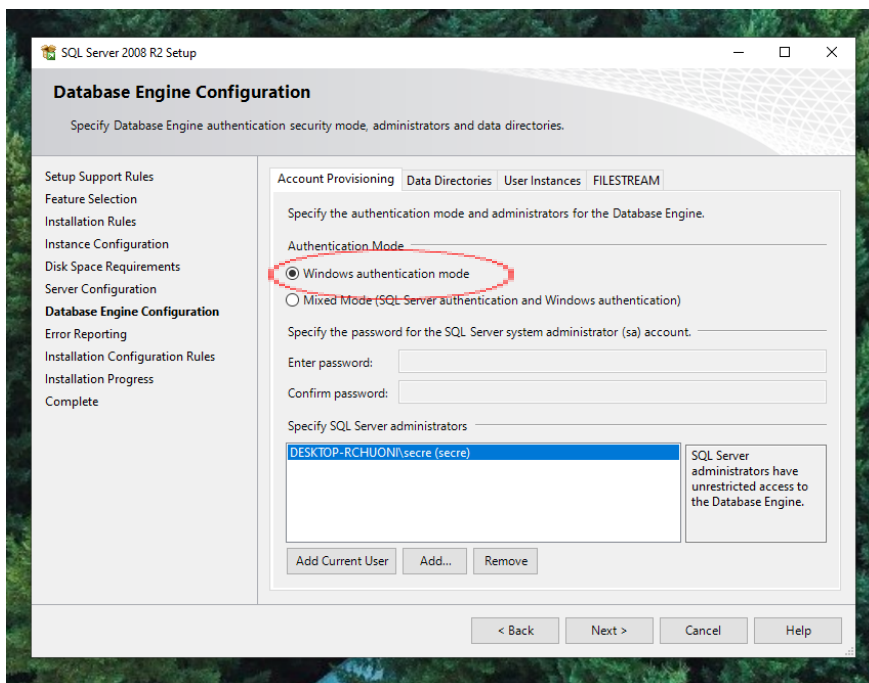
14. On Server Configuration, keep everything as they are.



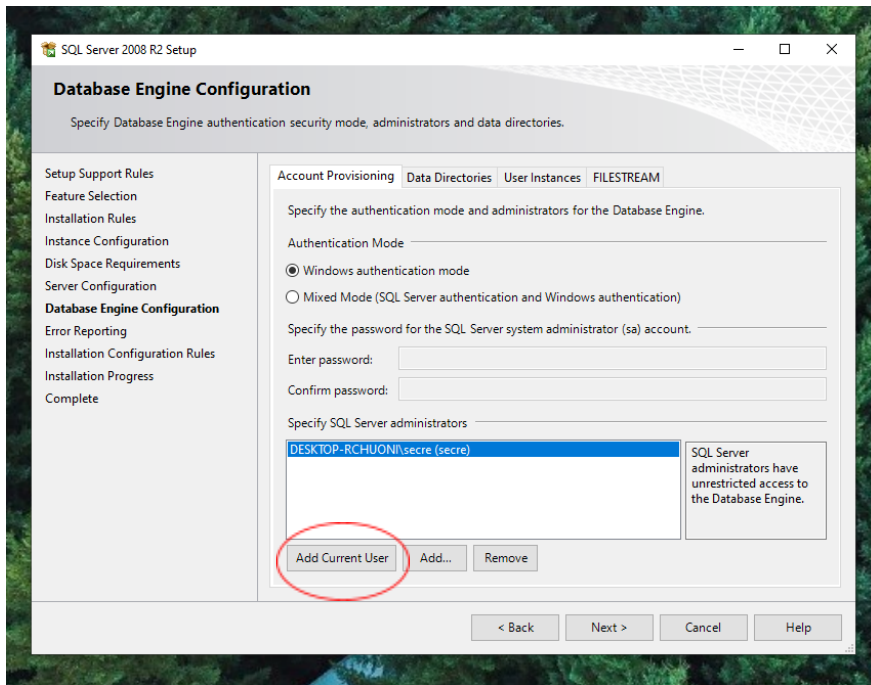
15. Click "Next".



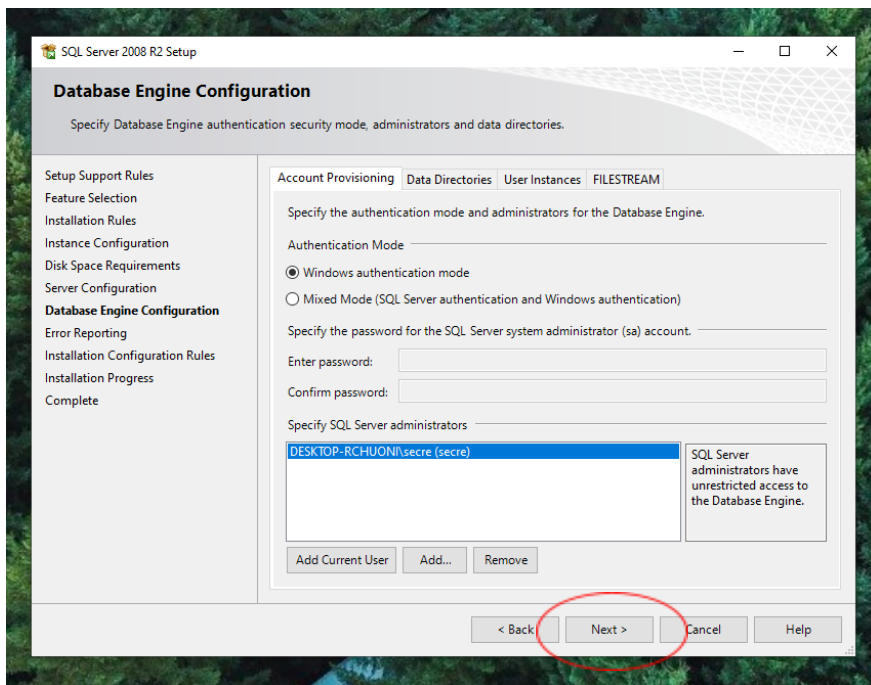
16. On Database Engine Configuration, under Authentication mode, choose "Windows authentication mode". NOTE: No need to change anything if this is already the setting.



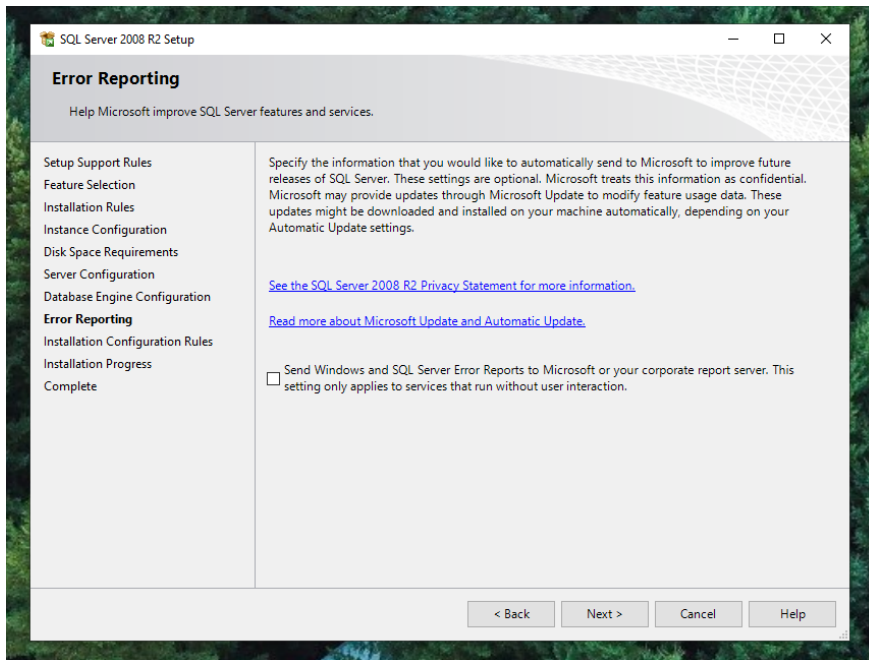
17. Under Specify SQL Server administrators, click "Add Current User".



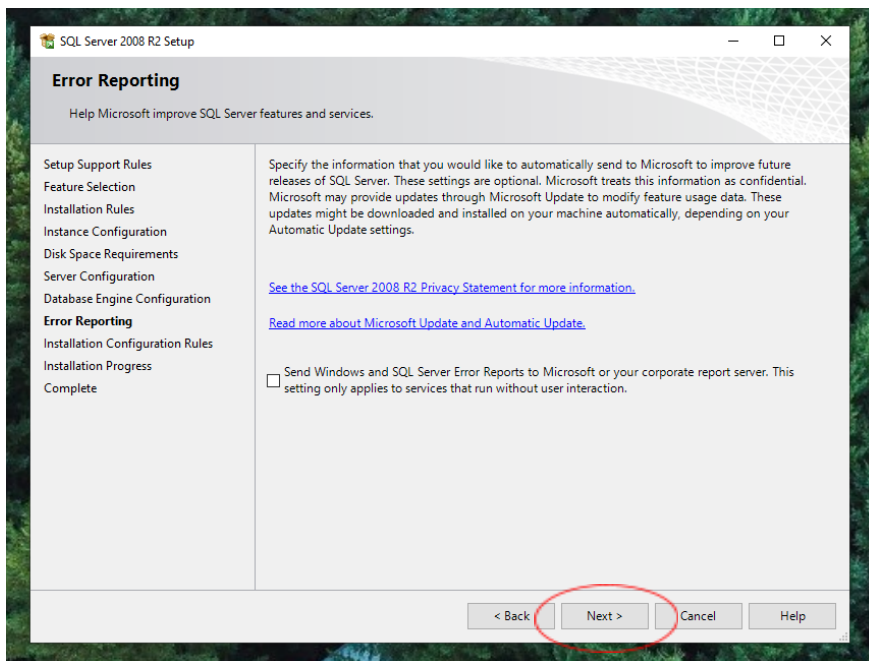
18. Click "Next".



19. On Error Reporting, keep everything as they are.

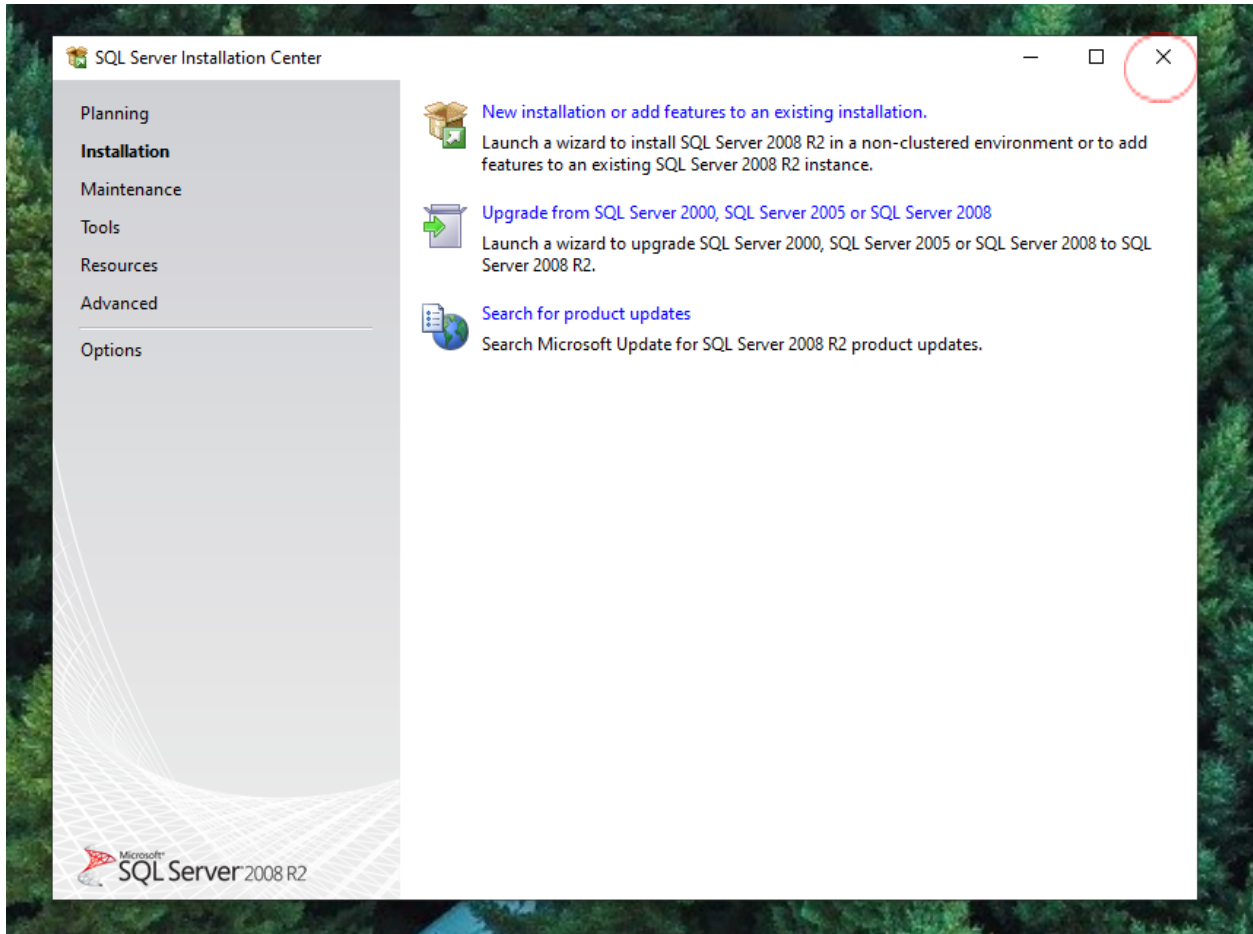


20. Click "Next" and wait for the installation to finish.

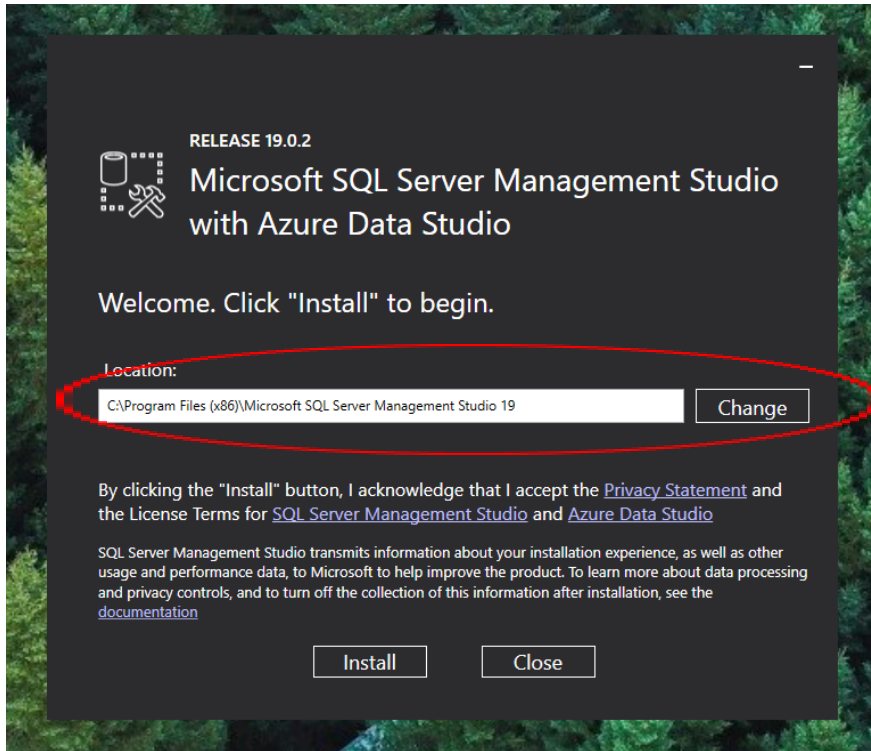

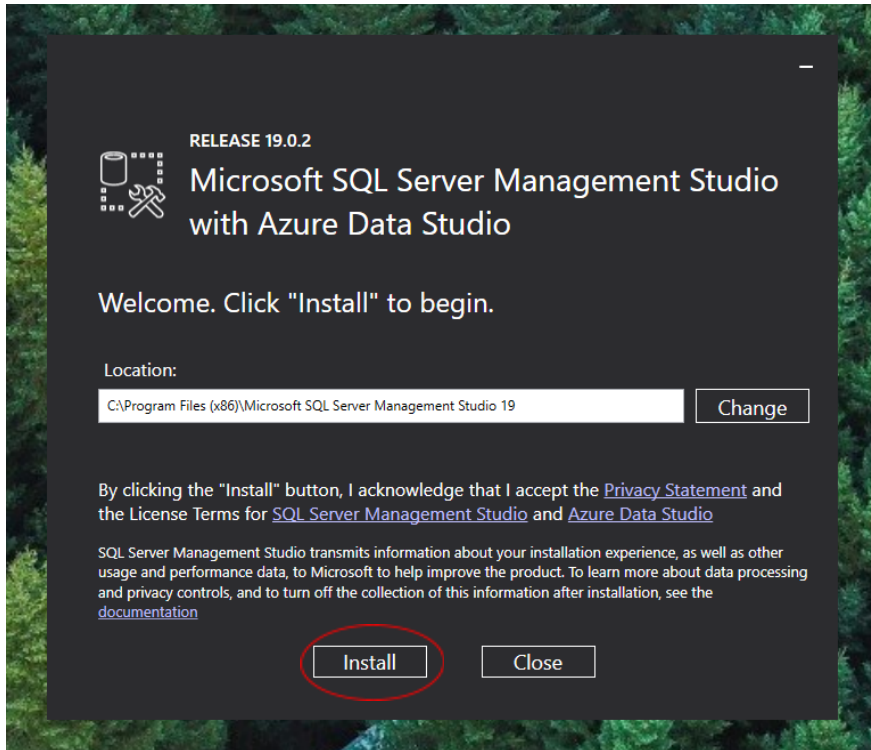
2. Click on “Free Download for SQL Server Management Studio (SSMS) 19.0.2”.
