
1. Double-click "PaycheckmasterInstaller.exe" to run the setup for Paycheckmaster Standard.




2. On the window that appears, click "Next".








5. Continue clicking "Next" until it starts the installation process.



6. Wait for the installation to finish.




7. Click "Close" to close the installation window. NOTE: Do not run Paycheckmaster Standard until you have completed all of the database installation and setup steps that follow.


11. On Instance Configuration, choose "Named instance" and input "SQLEXPRESS" in the following textbox. NOTE: No need to change anything if these are already the settings.








14. On Server Configuration, keep everything as they are.






16. On Database Engine Configuration, under Authentication mode, choose "Windows authentication mode". NOTE: No need to change anything if this is already the setting.




17. Under Specify SQL Server administrators, click "Add Current User".






19. On Error Reporting, keep everything as they are.



20. Click "Next" and wait for the installation to finish.




- 21. Click "Close" after the installation.

Installing Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio 19






- 2. Click on "Free Download for SQL Server Management Studio (SSMS) 19.0.2".
